# **HOSPITALITY:**

The Federación Nacional de Tenis de Guatemala, will provide accommodation and meals (3 meals per day) for the amount of players that each nation is allowed in each age division and/or category. In addition, accommodation, and meals (3 meals per day) will be provided for one coach per country. The nations that participate with more than 5 players will be allowed to name 2 official coaches. Hospitality for each team will begin with the night of Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup> and end with breakfast on Friday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

# **ENTRY FEE:**

**US\$100.00** per player and official coach. Payment must be in cash at the signin. The low entry fee is thanks to the support of the **Grand Slam Development Fund.** 

The official coaches must have an ITF ID from the Player's Support Program.

All entries must be endorsed by the players' National Federation.

# Attachment 1 COVID-19 Protocols

# **ITF Player and Coach Welfare Principle:**

For the International Tennis Federation & COTECC, ensuring the health and welfare of the players, coaches, and support staff participating on any ITF/GSDF event or tour is paramount.

#### Introduction

In view of the health risks posed by COVID-19, the "ITF COVID-19 protocols" have been established to outline the procedures to be followed while participating in a tour or ITF event to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, as well as measures to be implemented should any participant test positive or otherwise exhibit symptoms of or be exposed to COVID-19.

This protocol applies to the coaches, players and support staff of the Team, and any person in contact with the Team or its members.

At all times, all members of the Teams **must** comply with the guidelines of local government regulations and public health requirements, including where they go beyond these protocols.

# Goal of the protocols

The objective of these protocols is to protect players, coaches, and support staff "the Team"; and anyone outside "the Team", as well as the public, from the risk of COVID-19 transmission. In addition, these guidelines outline the procedures to be followed in case of a positive COVID-19 test, or symptoms or exposure to COVID-19 and with whom the responsibilities lie.

#### **Protocol guidelines**

All players and coaches will be asked to present a negative PCR or antigen test result done within 72 hrs. before travelling. Players and coaches will also have to sign a declaration 72 hrs. before travelling.

# **During the tournament– Players, Coaches and Support Staff Behavior**

- Please note that social distancing from all other people at all times (including those within your bubble) is compulsory. If you are deemed to be a "close contact" of a person who is COVID-19 positive, you may be withdrawn from the tournament and possibly subsequent tournaments. The term "close contact" is defined as anyone with the following exposure to a COVID-19 case, from 2 days before to 14 days after the case's onset of illness:
  - ➤ Having direct physical contact or face-to-face contact (within 1 meter) with a COVID-19 case for any length of time.
  - ➤ Being between 1-2 meters of a COVID-19 case for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.

For the avoidance of doubt, anyone living in or sharing the same household or household-like setting (e.g., hotel room, apartment, or hostel) is automatically classed as a "close contact".

# **During the tournament - Accommodation**

- Coaches will stay in double rooms if they are from the same nation, if not they will stay in single rooms.
- Players will stay in triple rooms if they are from the same nation, if not they will stay in double or single rooms.
- Air conditioning should be set to use a fresh air supply, rather than recirculation, and air flow should be directed away from individuals.
- Windows and doors should be left open where reasonable to allow a good flow of fresh air.
- Clean any surface that may be contaminated.

# **During the tournament- Transportation**

Transportation will only be available from the hotel to the venue/hotel to airport and vice versa. Players are not allowed to go to shopping malls, restaurants, convenient stores, etc. unless in case of an emergency. In this case, the player and coach will have to get authorization from the ITF or COTECC representative.

- Wearing of masks is mandatory while on transport.
- Vehicles must be sanitized and disinfected after every trip.
- Allow for a free seat between players and coaches where possible.
- A maximum of 50% of the transport capacity will be allowed during the event.

# **During the tournament - Meals**

- Social distancing will be observed during meals where possible.
- Avoid sharing cups, eating utensils, food, and drinks with others.
- Buffet will not be served in chafing dishes. Thermal tables must be used with constant heat to keep the food warm and a see-through vinyl or glass protector to protect the food.

# Management of COVID-19 symptoms and cases

# **Financial responsibilities – Players and Coaches**

- Players and coaches are fully responsible for any costs associated with COVID-19 tests prior to and during the tour.
- Any hospitality costs from the official date of arrival to the official date of departure from the tournament will be the responsibility of the organizer.
- Any quarantine cost after the event is over will be covered by the player or coach, by their family or national federation.
